Required Qualifications

- Master's degree in Psychology.
- Ph.D. in Psychology (or near completion) is preferred. Candidates with a doctoral degree in a closely related field and a Master's degree in Psychology may also be considered..
- Excellent command of English, both spoken and written.
- Ability to teach university-level courses in English.
- Commitment to high-quality teaching and student support.
- Demonstrated interest in developing an academic career and/or professional expertise in Psychology.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in an international environment.

Preferred Areas of Expertise

We particularly welcome applicants whose expertise enables them to contribute to the education and professional preparation of future psychologists.

We especially welcome candidates whose research, teaching, or professional practice focuses on one or more of the following areas:

- Counselling Psychology
- Educational Psychology

- Quantitative Methods, Statistics, and Data Analysis in Psychology

Applicants with expertise in other areas of Psychology are also encouraged to apply.

Desirable Qualifications

- Previous university teaching experience.
- Experience teaching in English.
- Active involvement in research and scholarly publications.
- Relevant professional experience in psychological practice.
- Experience with grant-funded projects or international collaborations.
- Knowledge of Czech is an advantage but not a requirement.
- Experience working with culturally diverse student populations.

 - List of other professionally or academically relevant activities and outputs, including public outreach, consultancy, professional practice, reviewing, dissemination of knowledge, community engagement, or related activities.
 - List of courses taught and, where available, evidence of teaching effectiveness (e.g., student evaluations, peer observations, teaching awards).
- Contact details for two academic or professional references. Reference letters will be requested only from shortlisted candidates.
